

## **Player Code of Conduct**

I pledge to have and show a positive attitude and be responsible during my participation in the TCMBA by abiding by the following codes of conduct.

- 1. I will practice and encourage good sportsmanship with all players, coaches, umpires, officials and parents at every game, practice and event.

- 5. I will treat not only my coaches but also all coaches and game officials with respect and I will expect to be treated with respect in return.
- 6. I deserve to have fun during my baseball season and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun or an enjoyable experience.
- 7. I deserve to play in an alcohol, smoke and drug free environment and expect all participants to respect my wishes.
- 8. I will encourage my parents to be involved and support my team and me in some capacity, as it is important to me.
- 9. I will always try my best.
- 10. I will always try to be on time for games and practices.
- 11. I will remember that baseball is an opportunity to learn and to have fun.
- 12. I will respect the officials and accept their decisions without incident and will abide by the rules.
