



Player Code of Conduct

6. I deserve to have fun during my baseball season and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun or an enjoyable experience.
7. I deserve to play in an alcohol, smoke and drug free environment and expect all participants to respect my wishes.
8. I will encourage my parents to be involved and support my team and me in some capacity, as it is important to me.
9. I will always try my best.
10. I will always try to be on time for games and practices.
11. I will remember that baseball is an opportunity to learn and to have fun.
12. I will respect the officials and accept their decisions without incident and will abide by the rules.
